Lab Safety Contract



The EASTCONN Mobile Manufacturing Laboratory can provide you with an exciting opportunity to dive into the world of manufacturing; however, student safety is our main concern during all Mobile Lab activities. Please read the following, and sign below to confirm that you have read our safety guidelines and accepted the terms. This completed form must be returned to your teacher before you may enter the EASTCONN Mobile Manufacturing Lab.

Laboratory Safety Guidelines

1. Remember at all times that the Mobile Laboratory is a place for serious work. Students who are disruptive will be removed from the Lab.
2. Always follow written and verbal instructions carefully.
3. Students may not work in the Lab unless an instructor is present.
4. All student work must be conducted under the direct supervision of an instructor. Unauthorized use of the tools etc is not allowed.
5. Respect the equipment and your fellow Laboratory workers.
6. Safety equipment must be worn at all times when using the equipment. This may include chemical splash goggles, gloves and/or Lab aprons.
7. Do not taste anything in the Lab. **No food, drink or gum is allowed in the Mobile Lab.**
8. When observing the odor of a Lab substance in an approved container, avoid placing your face directly over the container. Instead, use your hand to lightly fan the scent toward your nose.
9. Upon entering the Mobile Manufacturing Lab, follow the orientation instructions from the instructor, including as appropriate noting the location of our blanket station, eyewash and the emergency fire-exit procedures. Also note the location of our Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) binder.
10. Report any accidents, no matter how minor, to both your instructor and the Mobile Lab instructor.
11. Keep your apparatus and work area organized. Avoid spills. If you do spill something, notify your instructor and Mobile Lab instructor immediately. They will advise you about how to clean the area.
12. Open-toed shoes/sandals, loose fitting clothing, and dangling jewelry **are not permitted** during Mobile Lab hand-on activities. Long hair must be tied back securely during hands-on Lab activities.
13. Books and notebooks must be stored under Lab stations for clear aisles and exiting. No backpacks are allowed.

In order to maintain a safe working environment for all occupants, any student out of compliance will be removed from the Laboratory. This is for your own protection and that of your fellow students.
